

MINUTES
CITY COUNCIL CALLED MEETING
JANUARY 8, 2008

The Jackson, Tennessee City Council met for a called meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 8, 2008, in the George A. Smith Meeting Room at City Hall with Mayor Jerry Gist and Council members Charles "Pepper" Bray; Ernest Brooks, II; Harvey Buchanan; Johnny Dodd; Maurice Hays; Frank Neudecker; Charles Rahm; and Randy Wallace present. Council member Danny Ellis listened by telephone. Also present was Anita Brooks, recorder of the minutes.

Mayor Jerry Gist gave the invocation and led the audience in the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

Dr. Vicki Lake, Chairperson of the Safe Neighborhoods Task Force Steering Committee, presented the committee's recommendations to the public.
